To develop links with organizations outside the Cochrane Collaboration and with the Cochrane Review Groups, centers and fields.

To maintain a contact database and a mailing list of all field members.

To introduce to Review Groups editors, peer reviewers, or authors with Field-relevant expertise.

To identify and tag in the Cochrane Collaboration's central server <u>Archie</u> all reviews, protocols and titles relevant to our Field.

To notify gaps in evidence for pre-hospital and emergency health care to the Cochrane Review Groups.

To reformat and/or comment on Cochrane reviews relevant to our Field.

To disseminate the Cochrane reviews through newsletters on regular basis.

To create and maintain a website informing about the Field's activities.

To organize meetings and presentations at key international conferences with Cochrane-dedicated training and information sessions.

To encourage emergency medicine journal editors to publish information about the Cochrane Collaboration and other evidence-based resources.

To advise and assist authors of reviews within the Field's scope with publishing Cochrane reviews in journal article format in specialist journals.

To seek sufficient funding to support health research activities.
